

New private clinic opens in North York

A private clinic opens in North York today with a new approach for cancer patients.

Medicor services start at \$2,500 but doctors at the clinic will not be diagnosing or treating patients.

Instead, doctors will offer comprehensive aide in dealing with cancer patients, advice on the navigating the health care system and help with arranging appointments.

Patients will be able to discuss all aspects of their condition with doctors and will be provided with a hand held computer device where all their records will be stored. The province will be watching the clinic carefully to ensure doctors are following proper guidelines and to ensure no laws are being broken.

One North York resident believes the clinic will be a valuable addition to the community, "I would think it's actually a pretty good service. It's a shame that not everyone can have that kind of access immediately, but the reality of our health care system is that sometimes you don't get the care you need as fast as you do."
